CLAM CHOWDER CONTEST FAQs

Clam Chowder Contest will be from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m.

All chowder must be made by you, the contestant. No mixes or canned soups or chowders will be allowed. Contestants must precook their chowder.

It is recommend that each contestant cook around 10 gallons of chowder. Although not required, this will allow for a 2 oz. to 4oz. sample for approx. 330 attendees. Contestants will be allowed to sell their chowder, if they wish, in addition to tastings.

All contestants will need to supply their own tables, chairs, displays, and/or pop-up tents. In addition, the contestant will provide signage or material identifying the contestant, all necessary cooking and serving utensils, appropriate means for maintaining the serving temperature of the chowder throughout the contest and any other decorations or props.

All tasting cups, serving bowls (if selling), and spoons must be provided by contestants.

Be advised The Promenade is on the water and can be extremely windy with high wind gusts. Weights are required to hold down pop-up tents and other equipment and supplies. No electricity will be available.

Judging for this event is for “Judges’ Choice” and “People’s Choice.” Judges will taste the chowder prior to the opening of the Lighthouse Point Festival (11:45 a.m.). Attendees with vote for People’s Choice with tokens (until 2 p.m.). Presentation of awards will take place at 3:30 pm.

All contestants must have completed an official contract and paid a non-refundable fee of \$25 to the NLM no later than July 31, 2017.
